We crafted a concert that explores the stories, lore, and experiences of the veil to allow space to process loss, feel comfort, and find connection. Concinnity is honored to perform this program at St. Peter's Episcopal Church, which is almost 200 years old, as it feels like stepping back in time. The inclusion of dance in the choral performance is another way to experience a deeper level of connection that art can provide us.
